GENERAL INFORMATION:

STUDENTS:

- ➤ JUNIORS: NCYL Applications are now available in the guidance office. NCYL (National Council Youth Leadership) fosters high ideals of leadership and integrity among the youth of America. Their Youth Salute, a 2 day leadership conference is held at Drake University in September which will involve over 250 students from central lowa. 10 Students will be selected from IHS. Juniors must have a 3.00 GPA and be involved in at least one extracurricular activity in or out of school to qualify. All nominations are due by Thursday, Feb 8 in the Guidance Office.
- **Requesting Homework:** Students if you are absent due to an illness and are wanting homework, we encourage you to email your teachers (you can find their emails on PowerSchool).
- ➤ Guidelines for Junior Opens, Late Arrival and Early Dismissal: To qualify for a true open, juniors need to have at least 36 credits and passed all their class from last semester, unless approved by a counselor. To quality for late arrival or early dismissal, juniors need to have at least 24 credits and have passed all their classes from last semester. The form is available in the guidance office and must be completed and turned in to Dawn in the registrar's office before it takes effect.

Girls Interested in Cyber Security

A new, innovative cybersecurity training program offered by the SANS Institute offers young women in high school the opportunity to learn basic cybersecurity skills through a no-cost online game of discovery called Girls Go CyberStart.

Participating students do not need prior cybersecurity knowledge or programming experience. All that is required is a computer and an internet connection.

Young women in high school in lowa who excel in the Girls Go CyberStart game will have the opportunity to win computers and other prizes as well as a trip, with a parent, to the 2018 Women in CyberSecurity Conference.

Registration begins on January 29th and ends on February 16, 2018. The first 10,000 young women who have registered may play the game online from February 20th through 25th.
