Parents, the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) testing will take place throughout the week.

We ask the following so that students can perform their best during each assessment:

- 1. Get a good night's sleep
- 2. Eat a good breakfast. Remember, breakfast is served 7:30-8:00 in the cafeteria.
- 3. Avoid scheduling appointments if at all possible so that students may take tests at the planned time.
- 4. Avoid last-minute pick-ups if at all possible.
- 5. Many assessments will be taking place in the morning. Arrive to school on time!

Student Honor Code for ISASP **Students, Please Read**

The following will be read to students before each test this week.

These are expectations for student behavior during and after testing. Prohibited behaviors include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Using personal electronics to capture test items and responses.
- 2. Providing assistance to or accepting assistance from other students, which includes copying answers, using prearranged signals to provide answers, sharing used scratch paper, etc.
- 3. Discussing test items or responses with students who have not yet tested.
- 4. Sharing test tickets, or retaining tickets/scratch paper after testing.

During ISASP Testing:

Textbooks, unauthorized reference materials, cell phones, cameras, smart watches, portable music players, image/sound capturing devices, or social media sites are not to be accessed during testing times. They should be put in lockers if possible.

Students, make sure you charge your Chromebooks each night!
