ISASP Testing Continues this Week

The remaining Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) testing dates will be April 9, 11, and 16. The tests will take place 8:00-10:00 a.m. Then, from 10:00 until the end of the day, students will go to their regular classes for shortened periods of time. Testing will also take place on April 10 throughout the day during LA classes. The normal bell schedule will be followed that day.

*Update--We will follow a normal schedule on April 18.

Make-ups will take place every day as needed thru April 19.

PLEASE SCHEDULE APPOINTMENTS FOR YOUR CHILD DURING NON-ISASP TIMES! Here's why that is important:

*Once a teacher starts a test, late students will not be allowed to enter the classroom, and they will have to make up their test at a different time (which means they will miss a future class to do that).

*If your child has to pack up their things and leave a classroom during an assessment, they cause a disruption for the other students who are testing. Not only that, your child will have to be pulled from a future class to complete their test.

Your cooperation is appreciated by staff and students.

If you would like to donate healthy wrapped snacks for students to enjoy during testing, please have your child deliver them to their 4th period teacher, or they can be dropped off in the office.

Preparing Your Student for ISASP Testing

As with all assessments, parents should encourage their students to:

- Relax. There is no way students can study for this test, or know all of the answers.
- Get a good night's sleep. Going to bed a little earlier than normal will make sure that they are well rested for the next day.
- Eat a healthy breakfast. Food is energy.
- Come fully prepared to engage and participate to the best of their ability.
- Avoid Absences.
- Charge Chromebooks.
