## IMS School Hours

7:50: Students report to first class

8:00: School begins

3:20: School ends (2:20 on Wednesdays)

Parents, we are encouraging you to drop your child off as close to 7:50 as possible. Students should not arrive at school before 7:30, unless they are in a supervised activity. Doors open at 7:00.

There are designated waiting areas for students who arrive before 7:50: 8<sup>th</sup> grade—fieldhouse (east wall), 7<sup>th</sup> grade—fieldhouse (by bleachers), 6<sup>th</sup> grade—Street gym.

Breakfast will be served beginning at 7:30. Students should go directly to the cafeteria if they will be eating.

## Where to Drop Off and Pick Up Your Students

Students are to be dropped off at the main entrance or fieldhouse entrance in the mornings. Students not involved in morning sports or activities should not arrive before 7:30 a.m.

The 6<sup>th</sup> grade pick-up zone after school is the fieldhouse parking lot. The 7<sup>th</sup> grade pick-up zone is the west parking lot in front of the stadium. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade pick-up zone is the main entrance parking lot. If you have multiple students, you may select the pick-up zone you would like to use.

(Please call or email to report Absences and Late Arrivals.)

**Late Arrivals:** All students arriving to school after 8:00 will enter through the main entrance and check in to the office. If possible, please notify the office before 8:00 or send a note with student stating the reason for the tardy. You do not need to accompany your child into the school for late arrivals.

**Early Dismissals:** Please notify a secretary in advance if you will be picking your student up early. That way, we can give them a pass to leave the room quietly when it's time. You can do this by having your student bring a note to the office before 8:00, or by calling or emailing the office. We ask that you give us notice so that we can avoid disrupting classrooms with phone calls requesting that a child leave the room. A parent/guardian must come into the building to meet their child.

**Absences:** Please notify the office by 8:00 a.m. when your student will be absent. Clearly state the child's name, grade, date of absence, and reason for absence. Students may request homework directly from their teachers via email when they are absent.

## Activity Passes for 2023-2024

The Indianola Community School District would like to bring to your attention an amazing cost saving opportunity for you and your student. ICSD offers Activity Passes that allow your student entry into all High School and Middle School athletic home events, as well as some music events (the offer does not apply to special events and district/state playoffs).

The cost per pass is \$50. (The cost to attend games varies from \$3-\$6 based on the sport and level of competition.) Middle School students will have a sticker placed on their student ID to indicate they have purchased an Activity Pass. Student ID cards are handed out the first day of school.

### **There are two ways to purchase:**

2. In person at the Middle School office payable by cash (exact amount if possible, please) or check (made payable to Indianola Middle School).

### **Did You Already Buy an Activity Pass?**

Students will receive an ID card on the first day of school. If you purchased an activity pass for your child before August 18th, there will be a purple "23" sticker attached to the ID. If you purchased one but there is not a sticker, remind your child to stop in to the main office to get it. Students will be reminded of this during daily announcements, as well.

It is the student's responsibility to come to the office and get their sticker.
