Student Drop-off and Pick-up Reminders

- Vehicles MAY NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED in the "car rider lane" on Clinton Street from 7:30-8:20 AM and 2:40-3:25 PM. If you must leave your vehicle, please use an official parking space.
- Students MUST be IN CLASS at 7:50am. Per the Handbook: students will be counted tardy if they arrive within the first 10 minutes of the day. If they arrive after the first 10 minutes, they will be counted absent for the portion of the day they missed.
- Students arriving after 7:50am must enter through the main office.
- Dismissal for the bus begins at 3:00. Only bus students may be dismissed at this time.
- Dismissal for car riders and walkers begins at 3:05.
- Dismissal areas-
 - North Door - 1st, 3rd and 5th grades
 - Southwest Door- Kindergarten, 2nd and 4th grades
 - Families with children in multiple grade levels may decide on one designated pick-up area. Please notify the classroom teachers of your decision.
- If you need to pick your child up early, you will need to park in an official parking place, come into the main office and sign your child out.

Notes from the Transportation Department - 515-961-9592

- All bus students are expected to wear their seat belt during their bus route. If your child is having trouble with the seat belt, please ask the bus driver for help.
- The middle school is a transfer point only for before and after school. Parents should be dropping off and picking up their children at their attendance center if they have plans other than their typical bussing needs.
- According to the Student Transportation Handbook (found on the Indianola website): '... Elementary parents cannot pick up or drop off elementary students at the Middle School for transportation.'
