Please bring your license when you visit the school

If you have been a visitor to any of our Indianola schools during a typical day, you have been asked to show your license the first time so that a sticker could be given to you before you walk around the building. We had an upgrade to this security screening system on January 15, 2018, which is a good thing. However, we will not have access to past visitor records, so we will need to scan every person's license/ID as if it were their first visit. This upgrade took place on January 15, 2018 so, beginning January 16, 2018, every visitor will be required to show their license. Please keep in mind, if you are just coming into the main office you will not need to show your ID. If you are going anywhere else in the building during school hours, however, you will. - * Driver's License Bring your driver's license to the office when you visit. It will be scanned in order to issue a visitor's badge. This is a required step.
