




No 6th Grade Girls Circle this Tuesday

Activity Pass

If you purchased an activity pass for your child, there should be a "21" sticker attached to his/her student ID. If you purchased one but there is not a sticker, remind your child to stop in to the main office to get it. It is their responsibility to make sure their ID has the sticker.

If you haven't purchased an activity pass, there is still time. The cost is \$50 and it allows your student entry into home high school and middle school athletic events and some music events.
