The SAFE (Seatbelts Are For Everyone) program is a DCCCA initiative developed in 2008 which is focused on increasing teen restraint compliance through education, positive rewards, and enforcement. This teen-run peer-to-peer program is designed to reduce the number of motor vehicle-related injuries and fatalities among teens. For more than a decade, the SAFE program has been a part of KTSRO. In 2014, the program was added in Oklahoma. In 2016, we brought the program to Missouri, and SAFE expanded to lowa in 2021.


Indianola Middle School Student Council is supporting the SAFE program this year. Students were surveyed recently on their habits and driver's habits. Information gathered from the survey is below:

Please select: The last time you rode in a vehicle was the driver wearing a seatbelt? 630 responses




Please check the choice: What percentage of the time are the Drivers Belted when you are a passenger?

Please check the choice: What percentage of the time are you encouraging parents, friends, others to wear seatbelts while you are the passenger?






Please check the choice: What percentage of the time are the Passengers Belted when you are a passenger?
