GoGuardian Parent

GoGuardian Parent is a companion to the classroom management and internet

filtering tools that the district uses for Chromebooks issued to students. GoGuardian Parent was created to help provide additional educational support to administrators and teachers by allowing parents to see what sites and documents their children are browsing and providing parents with additional internet controls at home. The app gives parents a bird's eye view of the apps and websites that their kids are on most often and control over schoolissued devices during out-of-school hours. With this perspective, parents can be made aware of browsing behaviors, so they can encourage more effective internet browsing habits at home and at school.

What is included in this app:

- Top 5 summary of student browsing (apps, extensions, documents, and websites visited)
 Teacher interventions
 - 30-day view of websites, videos, documents, apps, and extensions
 - Ability to block websites on school-issued devices during out-of-school hours
- Ability to pause internet access on school-issued devices during out-of-school hours, either on-demand or at a scheduled time
- To access the app, please follow the instructions below:
 - Download the app
 - iPhone: Visit App Store, search for GoGuardian Parent, and tap the download button.
 - Android: Visit Google Play Store, search for GoGuardian Parent, and tap the download button.
 - After the app is successfully downloaded and installed:
 - Open it up and enter the email address registered with the school. Note: Only contacts listed in PowerSchool as "has custody" or "receives mail", with a primary email address, are eligible for a GoGuardian Parent account.
 - Login/Check Email: Check your email on your mobile device / phone for a link to log in to the app.
 - Tap the "Verify your email", and it will take you straight to the app. Note: If you don't have
 access to your email through the device you used to log in, tap on "Login with verification
 code", and copy and paste the verification code from the email into the app.

What are my parental/guardian and child's responsibilities?

We ask that students use their school-managed Google accounts and school-managed devices for educational purposes within the boundaries of ICSD's DLE Handbook & Agreement, as well as board approved appropriate use policies linked on our district's DLE webpage. When a student is off campus, parents are responsible for supervising internet access and usage. The new GoGuardian Parent app can help with this!

We encourage you to discuss rules for appropriate internet usage with your child, and reinforce lessons of digital citizenship and safety with him or her. (Please call or email to report Absences and Late Arrivals.)

Late Arrivals: All students arriving to school after 8:00 will enter through the main entrance and check in to the office. If possible, please notify the office before 8:00 or send a note with student stating the reason for the tardy. You <u>do not</u> need to accompany your child into the school for late arrivals.

Early Dismissals: <u>Please notify a secretary **in advance** if you will be picking your student up early.</u> That way, we can give them a pass to leave the room quietly when it's time. You can do this by having your student bring a note to the office before 8:00, or by calling or emailing the office. We ask that you give us notice so that we can avoid disrupting classrooms with phone calls requesting that a child leave the room. <u>A parent/guardian must come into the building to meet their child.</u>

Absences: Please notify the office by 8:00 a.m. when your student will be absent. Clearly state the child's name, grade, date of absence, and reason for absence. Students may request homework directly from their teachers via email when they are absent.

Please refer to the Student Handbook for all procedures, policies, and guidelines.

Requesting a Bus Pass

If your child needs to ride the bus home with a friend, the Transportation department must receive a parent request **no fewer than 3 business days before the day of the trip** to allow proper planning. Passes normally will be approved as long as there is room on the bus and the request is submitted on time. Activity Passes for 2023-2024

The Indianola Community School District would like to bring to your attention an amazing cost saving opportunity for you and your student. ICSD offers Activity Passes that allow your student entry into all High School and Middle School athletic home events, as well as some music events (the offer does not apply to special events and district/state playoffs).

The cost per pass is \$50. (The cost to attend games varies from \$3-\$6 based on the sport and level of competition.) Middle School students will have a sticker placed on their student ID to indicate they have purchased an Activity Pass. Student ID cards are handed out the first day of school.

There are two ways to purchase:

1. Online through Revtrak at this link: <u>https://indianola.revtrak.net/</u> OR

2. In person at the Middle School office payable by cash (exact amount if possible, please) or check (made payable to Indianola Middle School).

Did You Already Buy an Activity Pass?

Students will receive an ID card on the first day of school. If you purchased an activity pass for your child <u>before</u> <u>August 18th</u>, there will be a purple "23" sticker attached to the ID. If you purchased one but there is not a sticker, remind your child to stop in to the main office to get it. Students will be reminded of this during daily announcements, as well.

It is the student's responsibility to come to the office and get their sticker.
