REMINDER IMS Doors will not Unlock until 7:30 Each Morning

Parents, please note, **students should not arrive at school before 7:30 a.m. IMS doors will not unlock until that time.** So, for the safety of our students, please do not drop them off before 7:30 because they will not be able to get into the building.

Drop-Off/Pick-Up for 6th grade: Blake Fieldhouse entrance

Drop-Off/Pick-Up for 7th & 8th grades: Main Office entrance

Students eating breakfast at school may go the cafeteria between 7:30-7:50.

<u>Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up Info</u> <u>*Changes this Year*</u>

Drop-Off: 6th graders should be dropped off at the fieldhouse entrance. Both 7th & 8th graders should be dropped off at the main entrance. Students not involved in morning sports or activities should not arrive before 7:30 a.m. **The doors will not unlock until 7:30.**

Pick-Up: The 6th grade pick-up zone after school will be the fieldhouse parking lot. The <u>7th and 8th grade</u> pick-up zone will be the main entrance parking lot in front of the school. If you have multiple students, you may select the pick-up zone you would like to use.

PLEASE NOTE:

1. High school students will be parking in the west lot (in front of the stadium and the administration building). For safety reasons, we are advising that students not be picked up in that parking lot this year.

2. To avoid and help reduce the congestion that will occur during after school pick-up, especially this year with high school students added, our recommendation is to wait until 3:30 to pick up your child. By that time, most cars and the buses will be gone.

3. An easy solution for traffic difficulties is to have your kids ride the bus. Contact Transportation, 515.961.9500 x1620.

Late Arrivals, Early Dismissals, Absences

(Please call or email to report Absences and Late Arrivals.)

Late Arrivals: All students arriving to school after 8:00 will enter through the main entrance and check in to the office. If possible, please notify the office before 8:00 or send a note with student stating the reason for the tardy. You <u>do not</u> need to accompany your child into the school for late arrivals.

Early Dismissals: <u>Please notify a secretary **in advance** if you will be picking your student up early.</u> That way, we can give them a pass to leave the room quietly when it's time. You can do this by having your student bring a note to the office before 8:00, or by calling or emailing the office. We ask that you give us notice so that we can avoid disrupting classrooms with phone calls requesting that a child leave the room. <u>A parent/guardian must</u> <u>come into the building to meet their child.</u>

Absences: Please notify the office by 8:00 a.m. when your student will be absent. Clearly state the child's name, grade, date of absence, and reason for absence. Students may request homework directly from their teachers via email when they are absent.

*No food deliveries from outside vendors will be accepted; parents must deliver the food themselves, and it must be labeled with student's name.

*No caffeinated drinks

*Parents/guardians may only sign *their* child out for lunch; your child's friend may not leave with you unless his/her parent is also with you.

Requesting a Bus Pass

If your child needs to ride the bus home with a friend, the Transportation department must receive a parent request **3 business days before the day of the trip** to allow proper planning. Passes normally will be approved as long as there is room on the bus and the request is submitted on time. Activity Passes for 2024-2025

The Indianola Community School District would like to bring to your attention an amazing cost saving opportunity for you and your student. ICSD offers Activity Passes that allow your student entry into all High School and Middle School athletic home events, as well as some music events (the offer does not apply to special events and district/state playoffs).

The cost per pass is \$50. (The cost to attend games varies from \$3-\$6 based on the sport and level of competition.) Middle School students will have a sticker placed on their student ID to indicate they have purchased an Activity Pass. Student ID cards are handed out the first day of school.

There are two ways to purchase:

2. In person at the Middle School office payable by cash (exact amount if possible, please) or

check (made payable to Indianola Middle School).

Did You Already Buy an Activity Pass?

Students will receive an ID card on the first day of school. If you purchased an activity pass for your child <u>before August 19th</u>, there will be an orange "24" sticker attached to the ID. If you purchased one but there is not a sticker, remind your child to stop in to the main office to get it. Students will be reminded of this during daily announcements, as well.

It is the student's responsibility to come to the office and get their sticker.
