## INDIANOLA HIGH SCHOOL WALL OF DISTINCTION - GRADUATES

## Criteria For Selection:

- Nominee must have attended and graduated from Indianola High School.
- Twenty-five years or more must have elapsed since nominee graduated from Indianola High School.
- Nominee must have achieved by demonstrating outstanding scholarly, professional, and/or community service.
- Nominations must be submitted to the committee in writing, with documentation as to why the nominee should be selected. All nominations must be submitted by January 1.
- All nominations will remain active for three (3) years. If the nominee is not selected during this time their name will be placed on the inactive nomination list. Individuals may be nominated more than once, and will be added to the list for a three year period starting with the date of the last nomination.
- Nominees must receive a simple majority + 1 vote of the committee members present at the meeting to be selected. The vote will be by a confidential written ballot.
- There will be a maximum of two inductees each year including those in the Notable Educator category.
- The committee reserves the right to modify the selection protocol as agreed upon by the majority of the committee members, and make selections at their discretion.
