SILVER CORD OPPORTUNITIES:

SILVER CORD- The following is in the Silver Cord Handbook "*Students may choose to earn up to half of their silver cord hours volunteering for an ICSD organization as long as:* ○ *No varsity letter, school credit or grade is given.* ○ *The work is above and beyond what is expected.* ○ *The student or organization the student belongs to does not receive financial or other compensation. This includes but is not limited to revenue from direct sales, fundraisers or donations.* ○ *An exception is if the school organization donates the profits (less expenses) to charity. This exception should be approved in advance.*"

This rule will be followed from this point forward. If you have had hours counted (like working concession stand for your school group) in the past it will be counted toward your Silver Cord hours. However, from this point on it will not. Also you may only count 75 hours from one organization. For instance, you can only turn in 75 hours for theater crew or 75 hours for being a manager of a sports team. If those hours have been turned in before 2/20/22, they will be counted but not after that date. If you have any questions, please see Mrs Coghlan in the guidance office.
