In singles and doubles play, everyone was able to win their first round matches. Hannah Price and Hayden Laschanzky defeated their opponents in two sets as did the duel of Brynn Bishop/Kaelyn Kindelspire and Carmen Christensen/Audra Dowler.

In each player's second round matches, the competition stepped up significantly. In singles play Hannah Price battled extremely well against the #3 seed from Valley but fell in two sets. While this match took place, Hayden Laschanzky was able to defeat the #4 seed player from Ankeny in two sets playing one of her best matches of the season. In doubles play, Brynn Bishop and Kaelyn Kindelspire fell to the #1 seeded players from Waukee Northwest and Carmen Christensen and Audra Dowler battled extremely well against the #3 seeded team but fell in a 3 set super tie breaker match.

After Hayden's victory over the #4 seeded player, she took on the top seeded player in the district as well dealing with the extreme heat. Hayden fell in two sets but she represented herself and her school with extreme class.

The ladies will be traveling back to Valley next Tuesday for team competition to take on the winner of this Saturday's match against Des Moines North and Des Moines Roosevelt. The coaching staff is extremely proud of these young ladies, their commitment and outstanding representation of the Indianola School District.
