SPORTS:

GIRLS XC: The girls cross country team had a busy couple of days with meets on Thursday, September 7th in Marshalltown and Monday, September 11th in Huxley at Ballard.

Marshalltown is historically known as "The State Meet Preview" as there are many top ranked 4A schools attending. The Indians ran a very strong race and placed 10th in a strong field. Jordyn Brown led the charge placing 14th in 19:27.7- a lifetime PR that earns her the 6th best 5K time in school history. Paige Hoger followed Jordyn, placing 36th in a lifetime best time of 20:01.3- the 9th best 5K in school history! Hadley Erickson, Taylor Hoger, Leah Hartford, and Remy Sivertsen rounded out the Varsity lineup. 16 girls ran season best times at this meet! Melina Kingkade ran a lifetime best at this race!

The Ballard Meet is a meet loaded with a lot of the top 3A teams in the state. The Indians placed 2nd to LHC rival, Pella, in Class A. Pella won with 43 points and Indianola followed with 51 points. Gracie Foster led the Indians and WON the race in a season PR of 19:25.10. Other medal winners included Jordyn Brown, Hadley Erickson, and Leah Hartford. On the JV side, Rylee Tenges ran the race of her life and placed 4th. Piper Dahl also ran a season PR and placed 8th in the JV Race. Overall, the JV Indians placed an impressive 3rd!! The Indians will run at HOME at Pickard Park on September 21st. Come cheer us on!!

BOYS XC: The Indianola Boys Cross Country team competed at the 22 team Ballard Invitational on Monday night. Leading the way for the Indians were freshman Isaiah Thomsen (75th), sophomore Noah Kjellberg (99th), freshman Sam Nochvay (100th), junior Gavin Reed (104th), and seniors Luke Casey (106th), Wyatt Guely (114th), and Braelon Decker (122nd). The Indians will next race on Saturday at the Hartland Classic in Pella. Nice work guys!
