Parent Teacher Conferences for 9th – 12th Grade Fall Conferences are right around the corner and this year we will be utilizing an online conference scheduler (SignUp.com) for your convenience. Conferences are Tuesday, October 11th from 4:00-8:00, Wednesday, October 12th from 2:20-3:30, and Thursday, October 13th from 4:00-8:00. Each scheduled conference will be a 10 minute Zoom call. - Scroll to find your child's teacher. Click the orange "View" button to the right of their name.
- All of the dates and times will show up under the teacher's name. Select the "Hide Full Spots" checkbox to see only the available times. Look carefully at the date in the gray bar before clicking the green "Sign Up" button to the right of your preferred time.
- Enter your email address and select "Continue" and confirm your email address when prompted, if needed.
- Enter your password, if needed.
- You will be directed to a window (Participant's Information); enter info in the "Name", # of Spots, Phone, "Student's Full Name" and Teacher's Name" fields.
- Be sure to select "Save and Done."
- You will receive an email confirmation within 20 minutes after completing your sign-up. In the email confirmation, it will confirm your date, time and Zoom link for the teacher.

Click on the Zoom Link from your confirmation email right before it is time for your conference to start. Once you log in, you will be placed in a "waiting room" until the teacher is ready to start the conference. It is important that you "arrive" at your appointed time.

****PLEASE NOTE** You must schedule conferences by 3:00 p.m. on October 7th. After that, all conferences will be locked, and you will not be able to schedule appointments**
