**GIRLS CROSS COUNTRY:** The Indianola Girls XC Team competed in the Little Hawkeye Conference Meet on Monday, Oct. 10th at Dallas-Center Grimes. **After an absolute BATTLE of a race, the varsity team placed 2nd, falling to Pella by 3 points.** Dallas Center-Grimes placed 3rd. 4 Indians earned All-Conference Honors, placing in the top 15 in the race. Gracie Foster was 5th, Bree Tenges was 6th, Taylor Hoger was 8th, and Emily Naughton was 12th. Rounding out our lineup was Remy Sivertsen with a 4 second PR, placing 17th, Jordyn Brown placed 18th, and Leah Hartford placed 20th. We ran a tight pack! ...It's quite impressive to have all 7 in the Top 20!

**The JV Girls** ran their final race of the season at the LHC Meet. **They ran a strong race and placed 3rd behind 1st place DCG, and 2nd place Pella. Four girls earned JV All-Conference honors.** Piper Dahl led the team, placing 6th. Kayla Etnyre placed 10th, Melina Kingkade placed 12th, and Anna Blanchard placed 14th. Just missing the 15-spot cut off was Lydia Mahlstadt in 16th with a lifetime best by 30 seconds. Rounding out the JV top 7 was Cailey Baker in 17th, and Kate Baker in 21st. Senior Carly Richards ran a huge season PR by 1 minute and 13 seconds. She was just 8 seconds shy of a lifetime PR! Senior Katie O'Neil finished her first 5K of the season after spending months working on recovering from an injury this spring. So proud of their efforts! Thank you to JV Seniors, Maren Haynes, Carly Richards, and Katie O'Neil for your dedication to this team for 4 years. Congratulations on reaching your final finish line for the Indians.

The varsity team will continue running in the post-season. They will race at Pickard Park on Wednesday, October 19th at 4pm for the State Qualifying Meet. Come cheer on the Indians and help us qualify for State!! More greatness to come!
