PRIDE OF INDIANOLA MARCHING BAND: The 152 member Pride of Indianola Marching Band had another great marching season! The band had a total of 13 public performances in 8 weeks---5 home football games, 2 school assemblies, 2 parades and 4 marching contests. The marching band was 6th place at the Urbandale Marching Invitational on September 30, a 9th place at the Valleyfest day show on October 7, and 5th place at the Waukee Warrior Marching Invitational on October 14. The band also earned a school record 10th straight Division 1 Rating at the IHSMA Marching Band Festival on October 14. It was also the highest score for the band over the past decade at State Marching Contest! The IHS Color Guard, instructed by Audrey Chambers, was also ranked 2nd at Valleyfest and the Waukee Marching Invitational!
