**GIRLS XC:** The Girls of Indianola Cross Country made (her)story at the State Cross Country Championships! In their best team finish in 5K school history, the Indy Girls placed 12th at the State Meet. Leading the way for the Indians was Gracie Foster. Gracie earned All-State Honors, placing 7th in a SCHOOL RECORD time of 18:17.1. Hadley Erickson was the next Indy Girl to cross the line, placing 53rd in a lifetime PR of 19:28.7. Jordyn Brown was 63rd and ran 19:43.0, Paige Hoger placed 81st in a time of 19:58.3. Rounding out the scoring five was Lilly Hoger, placing 102nd with a lifetime PR of 20:13.0. Leah Hartford was 111th in a time of 20:27.9, and Remy Sivertsen was 126th in 21:09.3. Congratulations on an impressive season, girls!!
