PARENTS:

ELIGIBILITY: Scholarship rule will be back in effect at the end of the semester. If a student fails a class, he or she must sit for 30 days. If they are in a winter activity, those 30 days would begin immediately. If they are in an activity after that, the 30 days are dictated by the IHSAA, IGHSAU and IHSMA. During these 30 days, student-athletes are expected to remain a part of the team. They can practice but are unable to compete or perform.
