FROM THE ATTENDANCE OFFICE:

There are two ways to inform the school of a tardy/absence/early dismissal.

- 1) The preferred means of communication is to send an email to ihsattendance@indianola.k12.ia.us. Please provide the student's first and last name in the email heading. In the email, please state the reason for the absence, and also any important information regarding requested early dismissal/arrival times, etc. This helps to provide us with an accurate record of all absences, which we keep on file for the year.
- 2) If you are unable to email, please call 515-961-9510, then press 1. Please be mindful that the morning hours prior to the start of the day are very hectic. If you leave a message, it will be handled in a timely manner.

All students use the West entrance doors when arriving and leaving during the school day.
