25-26 ONLINE COURSE REGISTRATION: Online class registration through PowerSchool is now working. If you have any questions please work with your parents/teachers/counselor/registrar to complete your registration. The directions provided in this email give a step by step process to complete the registration process. Please follow the process and refer to the instructions if you need help. Some reminders when looking at courses and when they are offered keep in mind a course that is offered in the 1st Semester will end in the number 0 and a course offered in the 2nd semester will end in a 5. You can also refer to the course handbook and see these numbers on the first page in each section that lists all the courses offered in each department. This page will also tell you if a course is a year long course or a semester course. Remember for year long courses you must select both semesters. **This process should be completed by Thursday 2/20/25.**
