BELL SCHEDULE CHANGE: With next week being a short week with Thanksgiving, we have altered our schedule for <u>Wednesday</u>. November 27. We will still be getting out at the normal 2:10 pm dismissal time.

There will be NO SCHOOL on Thursday, November 28 and Friday, November 29.

PARKING: Now that we are about three fourths of the way through the first semester, here are some reminders on the parking assignments and guidelines.

- 1) Your car must be registered in order to park on school grounds. If you change your vehicle at any time, please update the Google form, send any email to one of the secretaries or stop in the main office.
- 2) You must have your parking tag visible. This means on the rearview mirror or dashboard with the number facing outside.
- 3) Freshman and sophomores are to be parking in the stadium parking lot. Juniors and Seniors are to park in the lot west of the high school.
- 4) Your parking tag is associated with your vehicle(s) that you have registered.
- 5) If you are an underclassman and have early morning practices, you may park in the west lot BUT you must have your vehicle before the start of the school day.

Please review <u>THIS</u> video regarding our High School Parking Lot changes for staff and students due to the high school construction project.

You can also review the <u>24-25 Parking Communication Letter</u> that was sent out at the beginning of the school year.

If students are found parking in the incorrect lot, selling their parking tag, or using a parking tag not issued to them, they will be given a warning first with an email sent to parents and you will be asked to move your vehicle. A second violation results in a \$5 fine and email. A third violation will result in a \$10 fine and email. A fourth violation may result in parking privileges being suspended.

IHS Doors Open at 7:30 A.M. Plan Accordingly Parents/Guardians/Students: Just a reminder that IHS doors do not open until 7:30 each morning. With weather changing, students should dress appropriately if they arrive at school before that time; jackets, long pants, umbrellas, etc.

2. Fill out your information

Must be the student's name and school email address. Double-check for correct spelling because this will be how it is printed in the book.

3. Select "upload your portrait"

Do not select upload candid. Be sure to select "upload portrait".

4. Verify that your photo meets the criteria listed and submit your photo.

5. All photos are due no later than Jan. 1, 2025. The submission will shut down at that time and you will no longer be able to submit.
