FROM THE ATTENDANCE OFFICE:

There are two ways to inform the school of a tardy/absence/early dismissal.

- 1) The preferred means of communication is to send an email to ihsattendance@indianola.k12.ia.us. Please provide the student's first and last name in the email heading. In the email, please state the specific reason for the absence. We have new attendance codes this year because of the legislative changes, so it is important to say what type of appointment your student is attending or other specific reason for their absence, early dismissal, or arrival time. This helps to provide us with an accurate record of all absences, which we keep on file for the year.
- 2) If you are unable to email, please call 515-961-9510, then press 1. Please be mindful that the morning hours prior to the start of the day are very hectic. If you leave a message, it will be handled in a timely manner.

All students use the West entrance doors when arriving late and leaving during the school day. If your student is tardy/leaving early/arriving late, THEY MUST ALWAYS SIGN IN AND OUT to ensure their attendance is marked correctly. Failure to do so will result in an unexcused absence until it is rectified.

SENIORS:

HOMECOMING COURT VOTING: Seniors check your emails for the link for the homecoming court ballot. Deadline is Wednesday, September 11 at the end of the school day.

SENIOR CLASS SELECTIONS: Seniors stop in the main office and find the purple binder to put your selections for class color(s), flower, motto and song. Deadline will be Friday, September 20 with voting taking place the week of September 23rd.

JOSTENS INFORMATIONAL MEETING: Jostens will be here on Thursday, September 19 at 1:00 p.m. in the auditorium to talk about cap/gown/announcements and hand out packets. They will return on Thursday, September 26 and Thursday, October 3 at 11:00-12:45 p.m. in the PD room to take your orders. If you have DMACC during that time, you will be able to pick up your packet in the main office the next morning.

STUDENTS:

PSAT: JUNIORS & SOPHOMORES: Indianola High School will be giving the PSAT Test on Tuesday October 8th, 2024 from 7:45a.m to 11:15a.m. Juniors may take this test to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship competition. National Merit Scholarships are some of the most prestigious scholarships offered in the United States and the only way to be considered for one of these scholarships is to take the PSAT. The guidance office recommends that juniors, who rank in the upper twenty percent of their class, and sophomores who rank in the upper fifteen percent of the sophomore class, take the exam. Typically students who place at the upper part of the 98 percentile or at the 99 percentile are named as semifinalists.

Sophomores may take the test as practice, but their scores are not entered in the National Merit competition.

The cost to take this test is \$16.00. If you would like to take the test, please stop in the guidance office and see Halee for a registration form. You must return the registration form along with cash or a check made payable to Indianola High School in the amount of \$16.00.

If you register for the PSAT, you must attend a mandatory informational meeting during advisory on Wednesday, October 3rd, in the media center. At that time you will be given information regarding the PSAT and also complete the test informational page.

We only have 35 tests so registration is limited to the first students to return payment with their registration forms. Juniors will be given a priority status. **REGISTRATION FORMS AND PAYMENT ARE DUE TO HALEE IN THE GUIDANCE OFFICE ON FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 27th.**

Must be the student's name and school email address. Double-check for correct spelling because this will be how it is printed in the book.

3. Select "upload your portrait"

- 4. Verify that your photo meets the criteria listed and submit your photo.
- 5. All photos are due no later than Jan. 1, 2025. The submission will shut down at that time and you will no longer be able to submit.


The Beverly Hillbillies Cast
