ATTENDANCE: ihsattendance@indianola.k12.ia.us

ATTENDANCE OFFICE: Students, any time you arrive late, are leaving early, or are returning to the building, you must sign in and out in the attendance office. Failure to do so may result in your attendance not being accurate. This is your responsibility. Also, if you know that you are leaving and have a dismissal pass to pick up, you can stop by any time during the day to pick it up. You do not need to wait to hear your name called over the intercom. The pass is for you to give to your teacher, not the attendance office.

SENIORS:

SENIOR CHROMEBOOKS (From the IT Department): As the end of the school year approaches, we want to address a few questions that usually come up regarding senior student Chromebooks and their chargers.

Due to state laws governing the use of taxpayer funds, students are unable to purchase their Chromebooks upon graduation. We understand the sentimental attachment students may have developed to their devices, but returning them is necessary to comply with state regulations. It also allows the district to redistribute the devices to our kindergarten students for the upcoming school year.

Also, we want to remind everyone about the return of Chromebook chargers. In the past, there have been instances of missing chargers, which poses challenges for the continued use of these devices in the future. To address this problem, we need to issue a fine of \$15.99 for any missing chargers. We kindly request your cooperation in returning the chargers along with the Chromebooks. Only district-provided chargers will be accepted.

Lastly, if students have placed stickers on their devices, they will all need to be removed. Removing stickers before the turn-in date will speed up the process. We recommend using Goo Gone® to remove sticky residue, as it will not damage the Chromebook's outer shell. We have Goo Gone®, and other cleaners, available in our Digital Learning Environment (DLE) office at the high school.

Detailed instructions regarding the date and time for Chromebook turn-in will be communicated to students next month.


SPORTS:
