



The Indianola Basketball Association (IBA) is committed to providing an opportunity for Indianola youth to learn about the game of basketball in a fun and competitive environment, in consultation with the Indianola High School girls' and boys' programs, to ensure all players have the opportunity to participate.

High School coaches will assess players in 3rd-8th grade to help form teams in each division. "The Academy" has been established as an option for any player who doesn't make a team to allow them to practice to enhance skill development and knowledge of the game. Players in The Academy will not play in the IBA league but may play in a tournament at the coach's discretion.

The IBA will hold a league in Indianola for boys and girls grades 3-8 (Oct.-Dec) and support practice times for teams choosing to continue into tournaments.

3rd Grade Boys and Girls:

- All kids interested in participating in IBA basketball will attend an assessment session held by the HS basketball staff. The dates and times are listed below.
- Assessments will cost \$50 and go towards each player's IBA dues (IBA league costs, practice times, and insurance).
- Past team affiliations and commitment to the IBA team schedule (games and practice) will be noted on the registration form and considered when placed on a team.
- Parents will be asked to coach each team voluntarily. Interest in coaching will be indicated when registering for the assessment day.
- If coaches/parents want to continue with teams for tournaments, they may continue utilizing their assigned practice times. Tournament sign-up and fees will be the responsibility of the coach.
- A uniform template will be provided, and teams will order their own jerseys and shorts or just jerseys.
- The IBA will support any Indianola teams already formed before the 2022-23 season. They may continue as-is if they'd like; however, they will be charged as an out-of-town team for the IBA league (\$575/team) plus a \$100 fee to secure practice space.
